Digitization – The power of information

Do we have any chance of developing sound strategies for a world of such growing complexity if we work alone? Not likely! This insight – though hard to swallow – has been accepted. But do we already have streamlined processes in place to share the information we consider important when interfacing with our partners? Why should we be better equipped to deal with this tomorrow?

Compliance – “Corruption? No thank you!”

We need to network – ideally in all directions. Create crowd solutions, promote disruptive ideas. We must share information – quickly and across cultural and continental divides. How can we master the flow of money in the supply chain, today and in the future?
